When the lockdown ends, the nation will need the help of your wheels to get back on its feet. So here are a few maintenance tips to keep your fleet ready to roll after the lockdown.



BATTERY

Disconnect the battery to keep the charge from draining below the level required to start up. Alternatively, start up the vehicle every 5-7 days and let it idle for 15-20 minutes.



HANDBRAKE

Leave the vehicle parked in first gear instead of using the handbrake. Additionally, place a piece of wood or brick just behind the tyres to

prevent it from rolling.



EXHAUST PORT

Seal all exhaust ports, air intakes and other vents to keep rodents out. Make a list so that you don't forget to unseal them when you finally start up the vehicle.



RODENTS

Apply rodent repellent in the garage and clean the truck of any food scraps to avoid unwanted visitors.



TVPFS

Make sure the tyres are inflated to the maximum prescribed pressure level to avoid flat spots.



FUEL

Top up the fuel to prevent moisture from building up on the walls and roof of the tank, causing it to rust.
